


S.S. "LOCH ETIVE".

It is submitted the Belfast Surveyors be informed that it is considered that the Convention requirements in regard to freeing ports on the raised quarter deck should be reasonably complied with, and it is noted that this is being done.

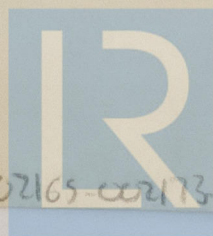
With regard to the casing doors these may be accepted as fitted.

The Surveyors reported an efficient gangway was provided from the bridge to the crew's quarters forward. It was assumed that the usual stanchions and lifelines were fitted and, therefore, no further provision was required, but if these were not fitted originally they should now be provided, and it is noted this is now being done.
