With reference to your Classing letter of the 5th instant, regarding the M.V. "LONGWOOD" Sunderland Report No.30449. I have to state that the tenacity of the boiler shell plates and straps is 29/33 tons and not 28/30 as noted on the Report. There are three lubricating oil pumps of Weir type, two working and one spare, each pump coupled ready for use, the size of each pump is 9" x 8" x 18" stroke with a capacity of 44 tons per hour and all connections fitted according to the Rules. I regret that this information was omitted from the Report.
