I beg to inform you that the T.S.S. "LUCITA" (Official No. 3551) of Willemstad, Curacao. N.W.I. has been surveyed in accordance with the International Load Line Convention Act 1930, for renewal or endorsement of the Load Line Certificate and all was found or has now been placed in an efficient condition.

The freeboard markings were verified by me this time and found as under:
