Dear Mr. Leeuwenburg,


With reference to Rotterdam F.E. Report No. 14213 on the new steamer "MARIANA", you will probably know that in accordance with our practice, full particulars of classification are not inserted in the Register Book until the fees have been paid.

We are now engaged in preparing the new edition of the Register Book, and shall be going to press with letter "M" on the 21st instant. In the circumstances we think it would perhaps be as well for you to draw the attention of the Builders to this fact, in case they might think it worth while to expedite the payment of the fees, with a view to getting full classification particulars into the forthcoming reprint.

Perhaps you would be good enough to make an enquiry in the right quarter, and let me know whether the fees are likely to be paid by the above date, or whether there are any other circumstances which I could bring to the notice of the authorities here, which would justify us in putting in the full classification when we go to press next week.
