Dear Mr. Watt,

With reference to the provisional freeboard assigned to Messrs. Swan Hunter & Wigham Richardso's No. 1234 ship, I note that according to the Secretary's letter of the 8th instant the freeboards have been computed on a corrected tonnage coefficient of .78, whilst the freeboard computation form shows the calculation has been based on a provisional coefficient of .77, and I presume the coefficient stated in the Secretary's letter to be a clerical error.

I would be obliged if you would kindly put me right on this matter before notifying the Builders.
