Dear Sirs,

M. I am in receipt of your letter of the 6th instant forwarding modified freeboard particulars together with a letter from Messrs. Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson, Ltd., respecting their S.S. No. 1234, and with regard thereto I enclose the usual printed letter setting forth the freeboards which have been provisionally assigned, subject to the particulars and dimensions now supplied being verified on completion of the vessel.

The freeboards have been computed on a corrected tonnage coefficient of ~~.78~~ and are subject to revision if found necessary. .77

When submitting your verification freeboard report I shall be glad if you will forward an estimate of the tonnage of the double bottom above the normal line of bottom longitudinal together with a builders' estimate of the under deck tonnage, assuming that 6" side framing and ordinary floors 32" deep are fitted throughout the vessel in conjunction with the usual ceiling and sparring.

At the same time I think it well to enclose a copy of the freeboard computation.
