IT IS FURTHER SUBMITTED postponement of the Special Survey until 1,56 merits approval.

IT IS ALSO SUBMITTED the Surveyor be advised that the shell and deck plating of this ship requires to be drilled to Rule requirements as the ship is now over 24 years old, also that it is concluded the thicknesses reported for shell plate A.8 (p & s) (5 & 6 mm respectively) are not generally indicative of the condition of this plate, but confirmation is desired, otherwise these plates will require to be dealt with at the Special Survey.
