I am in receipt of your letter of the 31st August, in further reference to the request made by the Owners of the above vessel that this Society should furnish them with a certificate stating the indicated horse-power of the engine, and in reply I have to inform you that, from the print forwarded with your letter of the 20th August it appears that the indicator diagrams are inaccurate. Accordingly, a certificate could not be issued in respect of an indicated horse-power based on these diagrams.


