Dear Sirs,

It is observed from your report No. 14345, in respect of the freeboards for the trawler "NOTRE DAME DE FRANCE", Messrs. Smith's Dock Co's No. 950 ship, that the trim by stern of this vessel is 6 feet; and in this connexion I shall be glad if you will state if this is the trim when loaded to the disc.

In addition, you should state the distance of the centre of area of the load water plane abaft the middle of the length of the vessel. If there are any sidelights below the upper deck, the height of the sill of the lowest of these above the top of the vessel's keel, and also its fore and aft position should be stated.
