than cast iron.

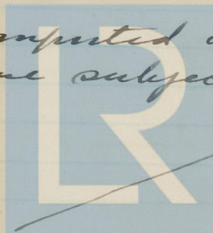
It is submitted the freeboards given on the accompanying form being those required by the Tables merit approval, the same to be marked on the vessel's sides, inserted in the certificate of classification, and recorded in the Register Book, subject to the particulars and dimensions now supplied being verified on completion, the usual covers being fitted to the openings in the steel bulkheads in way of tonnage opening, and efficient temporary covers being provided for closing the tonnage opening on shelter deck.

The freeboards are computed on a tonnage coefficient of $\frac{7}{2}$ ^{as given} and are subject to revision if required.
