This ship was built in 1925 by Messrs. Harland & Wolff, Ltd., and is unclassified.

With a view to classification with this Society plans and particulars have been examined in this Office and the Surveyors informed that provided the requirements of the Rules for a ship not built under survey be complied with, and a favourable report received, the ship could be recommended for the class 100A1 "With Freeboard". (SEE VERIFICATION FORM ATTACHED)

The Belfast Surveyors now forward a First Entry report and a report on Form Rpt.8, stating that the ship has been placed in drydock and the requirements of a Special Survey No.3 complied with.

It is submitted the ship appears worthy to be classed 100A1, ^{WITH FREEBOARD} with record of survey 10,34 and a notation of S.S.Bel.No.3-10,34
