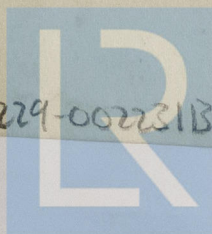
With reference to Glasgow Report No. 40971 on the Twin Screw Steamer "CAMERONIA" the Chief Ship Surveyors have raised the question of the date of build as they assume that the date given under your minute, 3-21, is the date recommended to be recorded. It appears to me, however, that this date is only the date of the last survey. Of course in the ordinary way the date of build in this case would be nine months after the date of launch, but perhaps you will let me know whether the date of build has been specially considered in this case, and if there would be any special reason for allowing fifteen months for the completion.
