I am in receipt of your letter of the 24th instant relating to the above installation.

Careful note has been taken of your remarks, and I am directed to inform you that in this instance it is considered the relief valves in the system could be set at 300 lb/in<sup>2</sup> in order to provide a liberal margin above the maximum working pressure likely to occur during the voyage.

In future cases, however, it is considered that the scantlings of similar pressure vessels should be in accordance with the Society's Rules, and the relief valves should be set at not more than 3% above the designed working pressure of the vessels.
