An access hatch has been fitted on the Upper Deck forward, within the forecastle, giving access to No. 1 Hold, 1'-11" x 1'-10", coaming 25" high x .40" thick, 2½" thick, wood hatch cover fitted fore and aft, 2½" bearing surface, cleats spaced 15" apart, 2 tarpaulins.

Access hatches have been fitted giving access to Nos. 2 and 3 Holds, one on the Upper Deck between main hatches Nos. 1 and 2, starboard side, and one on the Raised Quarter Deck, at the fore end of No.3 Hatch, port side, each hatch is 1'-11" x 1'-10", coaming 31" high x .44" thick, .42" plate cover, rubber jointed, secured by 8 - 3/4" dia. toggle bolts.
