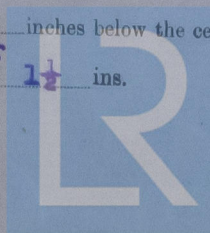

MAXIMUM LOAD-LINE in fresh water 4 inches above the centre of the disc.  
" " in Indian Seas in Summer 2 inches above the centre of the disc.

" " in Winter 2 1/2 inches below the centre of the disc.  
" " in Winter, North Atlantic 6 inches below the centre of the disc.
