The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee,

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The Middlesbrough Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated, and minor repairs effected. 16

The vessel has been lengthened by fitting a new fore end and a cruiser stern in accordance with the attached approved plans.

A deep tank forward has also been fitted as approved.

The equipment as originally supplied and now on board is in accordance with the Rule requirements for the increased dimensions, and has been approved.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 12,38 as recommended.

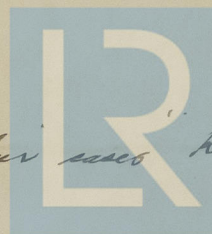
