



With reference to your letter of the 12th instant respecting the Convention Ordinary Freeboards computed in the case of the sailing vessel "ABRAHAM RYDBERG", Gothenburg C.11 port No.8895, which is returned herewith, I beg to enclose herewith the verification report of the new freeboards which have now been marked on the vessel's sides.
