Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines

Additional accommodation for gunners in bridge space at forward end.  
An escape hatch fitted on forward starboard side of bridge deck.  
Size 6'-5" high x 3'-6" long x 2'-6" wide x 1/4" thick. Wood clod fitted  
in after side of hatch 4'-6" x 2'-6" x 1 3/4". Height of sill 14"

An escape port complete with deadlight 14" diameter, height of sill 4'-8"  
above deck fitted in forward bulkhead of bridge space, and also  
2 ports complete with deadlights, 9 1/2" dia. fitted in this bulkhead,  
height of sill 5 feet above deck.

In ship side plating, 4 - 9 1/2" dia. ports complete with deadlights  
fitted, height of sill 5 feet above deck.
