Before, however, taking any action the Committee will be glad to be furnished with an expression of the Board's wishes in the matter.

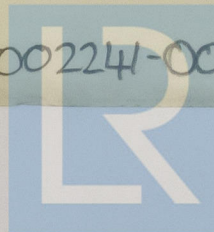
