With reference to your letter of the 19th August and my interim reply of the 13th instant regarding the case of the "GRAMSBERGEN", I have now had an official letter from the Groningen Surveyors to say that, apart from the number of fire extinguishers, all the remaining requirements of Chapter F of the Rules have been complied with.

In these circumstances it has been decided to adopt the suggestion made in the penultimate paragraph of your above mentioned letter as it applies to fire-fighting apparatus in motor rooms of Dutch coasters.
