

M.S. "KARABAGH", Blythwood Shipbuilding Co's Yard No.32.

A letter has been received from the Glasgow Secretary stating that this vessel is about to be completed and placed in commission, and that in reply to enquiry the Builders have been informed that the procedure to be adopted will be similar to that followed in the case of the motor vessel "PERMIAN" so far as it applies.

The plans of the "KARABAGH" were approved in the Glasgow Office in June 1930, and it is noted that the March Quarter 1932 Shipbuilding Return states that the vessel was nearly completed and that work had been suspended. The First Entry Report has not been forwarded.

It is submitted that in the first instance the Glasgow Secretary might be requested to furnish details of what remains to complete the survey during construction of this vessel.
