Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines
in APRIL, 1932.

Two new escape hatches have been fitted on the port side, one between
Nos. 1 and 2 hatchways on the fore deck and the other between Nos. 3 and
4 hatchways on the after deck.

The size of same is $4'4\frac{1}{2}"$ x $23\frac{1}{2}"$ and the coaming is 30" high by .40. The
watertight covers to the hatches are of steel .50 thick with rubber
jointing and 10 butterfly nuts. (Nwc. Aug. 1935).
