## ALTERATIONS TO CONDITIONS OF ASSIGNMENT OF LOADLINES

This ship has been under survey at BARROW

on 1st May, 1953 and the following alterations to the conditions of assignment of loadlines have now been effected/found:—

There is a bunker saddle-back hatchway on the fiddley top. Size 6'-3" x 3'-3". Coaming 18" high complete with wood covers, 1 tarpaulin, battening bars and wood wedges. There are two bunker hatchways in the bridge space (1 p. & 1 s.). Size 12'-0" x 2'-6". Coaming 18" high. Complete with wood covers, 1 tarpaulin, battening bars and wood wedges. There is a small store hatchway in the fore-cabin space size 2'-4" x 2'-0". Coaming 18" high complete with wood cover 1 tarpaulin, battening bars and wood wedges.
