Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

ALTERATIONS:- The following alterations noted on request of Owners' representative -

COMPANIONWAYS:- fitted on Nos. 2, 5 & 6 upper deck hatchways on instructions of the Ministry of War Transport for access for forces personnel to accommodation in Nos. 2, 5 & 6 'tween decks, one at each side of each of above hatches, strongly constructed of steel, secured to after end coaming and 1 hatch beam by E.W. (hatch beams bolted in place).


Openings in companionways at No. 2 & 5 Hatchways 5'3" x 3'9"; sill 33" above deck.

Openings in companionways at No. 6 hatchway 4'3" x 3'9"; sill 33" above deck.

Openings closed by hinged wood doors, capable of being operated from both sides and companions fitted with angles E.W. to front forming channels and 2½" stormboards and tarpaulins, cleats and battens for battening down.

Suitable arrangements also made for battening down main hatches in way of companions.
