Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines

NOW DONE:-

Port Side tween deck bunker trimming hatchway shortened and after part converted into entrance to Domestic Refrigerating Room - fitted with a strong steel companionway suitably stiffened, 6'4" long x 36" wide x 6'1" high above hatch coaming. Companionway fitted with a strong hinged steel door operated from both sides - opening 5'1" x 2'11" with 33" coaming. The size of the trimming hatchway is now 5'8" long x 36" wide. The existing entrance to the refrigerating room inside the engineers' accommodation was plated over.
