This vessel was built by Messrs. Bremer Vulkan in 1906 and classed with the Germanischer Lloyd.

With a view to classification with this Society plans and particulars have been examined in this Office and the Surveyors informed that provided the usual conditions be complied with and a favourable report be received the vessel could be favourably recommended for the class 100A1.

The Lisbon Surveyors, who were joined in the survey by Mr. Engledow, the Society's Senior Surveyor at Bilbao, now report the vessel placed in dry dock, and the requirements of the Rules for a vessel not built under survey carried out, and minor repairs effected.

The equipment of anchors appears to be in order but the chain cables require to be further examined and reported upon.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to be classed 100A1 with record of survey 5,27, and notation of S.S.Lis. 2nd No.3-5,27.


