Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 15th instant respecting the visit paid by Mr. Engledow to Lisbon to join the local Surveyors at that port in the survey for classification of the steamers "SAUDADES" and "MIRANDELLA", and may say that the reports advised therein have come to hand.

With regard to the question of the fees to be charged for these surveys, which I note Mr. Engledow has discussed with the Lisbon Surveyors, I have to say that the proposal to charge a total fee of £250 for the "SAUDADES" and £300 for the "MIRANDELLA" is considered satisfactory, and you will be good enough to advise the Lisbon Surveyors accordingly.

I have also to add that it is considered the same course should be followed as in the case of the steamer "AMARANTE" as regards the division of these fees, viz:- that 50% should be credited to the local Surveyors and the balance to this Office.

It is noted that the surveys of these vessels are not yet complete, but it is concluded that Mr. Engledow does'

not contemplate that it will be necessary for him to make a further visit to Lisbon in connexion with these surveys.

It is further noted that the Lisbon Surveyors have been advised of the amount of Mr. Engledow's expenses and that they should be equally divided between the two vessels.
