QUESTION

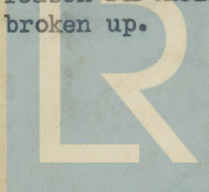
With reference to your letter of the 17th July and previous correspondence, I shall be glad to learn how this case stands regarding the outstanding surveys.

ANSWER

Date: 17th September, 1956.

The Owners have decided to sell this ship for breaking up purposes and she will be delivered to L. Hammond & Co. at Dublin in the course of the next few days.

They ask me to explain that their programme for this ship over the last two months has been delayed owing to the Dock Strike up here. They have come to the conclusion that it would be too expensive to put this ship through Special Survey again and that is the reason for their decision to have her broken up.
