LINDESNAS. — Stockholm, Apr. 17. — Swedish motor tanker Lindesnas, 1420 tons deadweight, Nynashamn for Norrköping, cargo kerosene, went aground outside Havringe Lighthouse at 4 a.m. on Apr. 17 and sank after approximately one hour; crew saved.

LINDESNAS. — Gothenburg, Apr. 18. — A report from Stockholm states that motor tanker Lindesnas grounded and subsequently sank in 67 metres depth between Norra Krankan and the entrance to Sodertelje channel on Wednesday (Apr. 17). Salvage vessel Titan was sent to the scene by Neptunbolaget, who report that it is not intended to attempt salvage. — "Goteborgs Handels- och Sjöfarts-Tidning." (See issue of Apr. 18.)
