

Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

The following alterations have been effected whilst vessel was undergoing a reconditioning survey at Liverpool in March, 1947 to January, 1948:

- (1) Structural alterations effected by extending lengths of Forecastle, Shelter deck sidehouses (P. & S) abreast of bridge front and extension of bridge aft end on Port side for additional accommodation.



- (2) Tonnage openings at ship side P & S and washport openings (2P. & 2S) on shelter deck abreast No.3 hatch now restored as formerly.

- (3) Portlights (3P & 3S) in Nos.1 & 6 lower Tween decks respectively removed and Shell openings efficiently closed with spigot plate blanks.

- Ship Side doors (5port and 5 stbd) in way of Nos.2,3,4,5 & 6 tween decks removed,
 (4) Shell openings efficiently plated over and internal structure in way made good.
