This tanker is 32 years old and is classed BS* qualified with the notation "Laid Up - Surveys Overdue".

The ship was last examined in drydock 6,53, and the SPECIAL SURVEY(D) became due 4,54.

The OSLO Surveyors report 11,54, ship generally examined afloat and found efficient for the voyage from Arendal to Blyth for breaking up purposes.

The ship has since been reported to have arrived at Blyth 28.11.54 and on 10.12.54 the Committee gave instructions for the record "To be broken up" to be inserted in the Register Book.
