Bulk Oil Steamship Co., Ltd., for installation in their motor tanker "PASS OF BRENDA".

It was stated that the engines, having serial Nos. 60/1846 and 60/7237 were originally built in 1937 and 1940 respectively under the inspection of a resident C.I.E.E.S. Inspector at the Dursley, Glos., Works, intended as search light sets, have since been converted for marine auxiliary purposes.

The Generating Sets were examined under full load running conditions during an extended test bed trial, the governing of the engines tried from full load to no load and found satisfactory. The two sets, so far as could be ascertained under running conditions, are in good and efficient condition.
