In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will obtain and forward full particulars as required on the back of report form 11b, together with the present lengths of the erections.

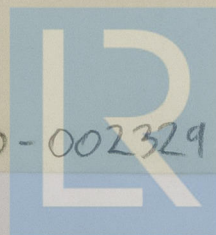
