Nature of Survey

This vessel, which was commenced by the Larne Shipbuilding Co., who are now in liquidation, is now to be towed by the Owners, (The Dundee, Perth and London Shipping Co.), to a port in the Clyde for completion and fitting of engines and boilers.

The hatch covers and tarpaulins have been fitted and the opening boarded up, and in the Surveyors' opinion the vessel is in a fit condition to proceed in tow.

It is submitted the Glasgow Surveyors be advised.
