Steamer "SAVONIA"

The Surveyors at Rotterdam have reported that this ship was under survey in April/May when the Special Survey was commenced in drydock.

The vessel was found to be in a generally very poor condition, and as a result of the examination carried out and the repairs which would have been necessary the Owners decided to sell the ship without any work being done. The Rotterdam Surveyors state that the ship left for Emden where it was stated she would be broken up.

The case received the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today when instructions were given for a notation to be recorded in the Register Book indicating that the class has been expunged on account of reported defects.

The former Owners in Finland should be advised accordingly if this is of any interest to them.
