This ship is 66 years old.

The previous history of this case is fully stated on endorsement dated 17.4.56.

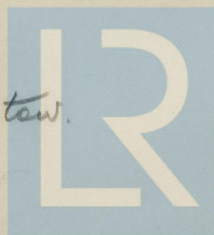
A SPECIAL SURVEY (C) became due 1.56, and due to the reported condition of this ship postponement of the Special Survey until ship's arrival at a North Continental port has been approved provided the Surveyors are satisfied that she is fit for such a voyage. Refer letter dated 20.4.56. An Owners' request for postponement of the Special Survey until 7.56 has been refused by the Committee.

The ROTTERDAM Surveyors report (5.56), this ship examined in dry dock, bottom coated and the requirements of a SPECIAL SURVEY (C) partly complied with.

The ship has been found to be in a generally very poor condition, and as a result of the examination the Owners have decided to sell the ship without carrying out any repairs. The ship is stated to have proceeded to Emden where she is apparently to be broken up.

In view of the above the case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
