Dear Sir,

In reply to London letter of the 20th instant respecting Glasgow Report No. 41214 on the Steamer "TIGER", I beg to state that the pillaring arrangements, spacing of transverses and transverse shell lugs clear of the oil tanks, and the thickness of the sheerstrake at the poop front are as approved; that all cargo tanks and oil fuel tanks have been tested as required, and that eight bulkheads only extend completely to the upper deck and six to the second deck, but the latter extend to the upper deck in way of the expansion trunk.
