advised about these two vessels.

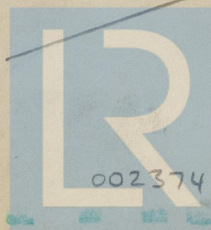
s.s. "Bengkalis". This vessel is also at present in
