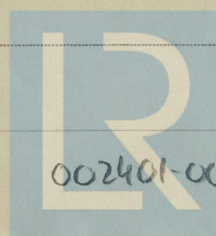
Now fitted 35 Butterworth Openings in Upper Deck, to main cargo tanks, each 12½" dia. Compensating steel ring elect. welded to deck 20½" outside dia., 3½" wide & 1" thick. Openings closed by .75" thick cover plates (steel) 20½" dia. secured by 12 - ¾" steel studs spaced approx. 4½" apart and with Tobin Bronze nuts.
