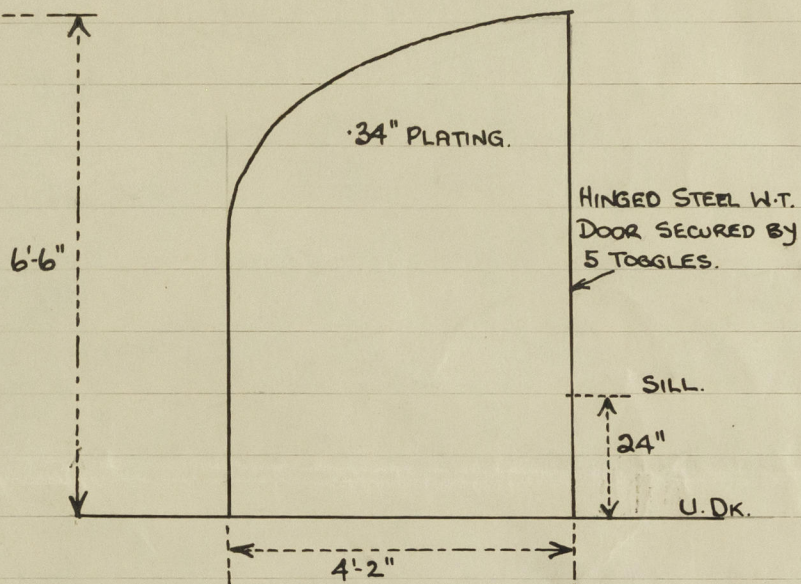

This ship has been under survey at SOUTH SHIELDS

on BETWEEN 31<sup>ST</sup> OCTOBER 1957 & 16<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 1958 and the following alterations to the conditions of assignment of loadlines have now been effected/~~made~~—

A COMPANIONWAY (STEEL) WAS FITTED IN LIEU OF THE ORIGINAL HATCH LEADING TO THE AUXILIARY PUMP ROOM, ON THE UPPER DECK (P.S. FORD). THE ACTUAL DECK OPENING REMAINING AS ORIGINAL.

BUTTERWORTH OPENINGS :-

AN EXTRA 11 BUTTERWORTH OPENINGS NOW FITTED IN THE UPPER DECK TO MAIN CARGO TANKS, EACH 12½" DIAMETER. COMPENSATING STEEL RING ELECTRICALLY WELDED TO DECK 20¼" OUTSIDE DIAMETER, 3½" WIDE AND 1" THICK. OPENINGS CLOSED BY .75" THICK STEEL COVER PLATES 20¼" DIAM. SECURED O.T. BY 12 - 7/8" STEEL STUDS SPACED APPROXIMATELY 4¾" APART AND WITH BRASS NUTS.
