
Nature of Survey

Frit entry

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee, the Glasgow Surveyors should be informed that this vessel has been taken to their port to be fitted with her machinery, and that to complete the survey for classification the engine and boiler casings require to be riveted up, after the machinery is fitted, and a kedge anchor of proper weight and test placed on board. On completion of these matters to their satisfaction they should report the same on form No. 8 for the information of the Committee, with a view to the classification of the vessel.
