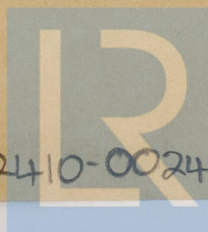
Alex. Craig, representative of Wm. Walker, Esq., Shipbuilder,
Lytham, survey the new steel screw steamer "AFRICA", of London, to
ascertain the position of the load line disc in relation to the water-
line, while the vessel was afloat in the Albert Harbour, Greenock,
the 16th. October, 1905.

The undersigned found the centre of the load line disc on star-
board side of vessel to be two inches (2") above waterline, and the
centre of the load line disc on port side to be two and a half inches
(2½") above waterline. Also found draft of water forward to be
ten feet, eight and a half inches (10'-8½"), and draft of water aft,
eleven feet, eleven inches (11'-11").
