S. With reference to Glasgow first entry reports Nos.41072 and 41073 on the engines and boilers built by Messrs.D.Rowan & Co., Ltd., designated Nos.739 and 740, I have to inform you that reports have now been received from the Society's Surveyors at Sunderland, from which it appears that these engines and boilers, which were originally sent to Barcelona, have now been reshipped to their port and opened up for examination. The various parts were found in good condition, and the same have now been fitted on board the new steamers "BYRNESS" and "RAMSHOPE" respectively (Messrs.J.L.Thompson & Sons' vessels Nos.550 and 551).

The first entry reports have to-day received the consideration of the Committee and the machinery has been assigned the notation of "PLMC 2.27" in each case.
