Dear Sir,

We beg to submit for consideration Messrs J.L. Thompson & Sons' ~~550 & 551~~ further proposals in regard to their Nos. 550 & 551, plans for which were approved on 13th instant and copies of same are now in London Office.

The Builders desire increased draught and for this purpose have increased the height of the R. Q. D. from 4ft to 4.27 ft. It is also proposed to stiffen the hatch coaming plates in the fore well as may be necessary to be considered a trunk.

The Builders propose to increase the thickness of the coaming plate to .5" and would like to know the nature of any further stiffening which would be required.

Plans of midship section, profile & decks and also a new profile plan showing the ~~reductions~~ ^{sections} of frames proposed to be fitted are forwarded herewith.


A freeboard calculation is also enclosed.
