Extra Accommodation in tween decks, after end (S.S.)

Companion fitted on top of tonnage opening (S.S.) opening 4'6" x 2'1"  
(12" sill above tonnage opening). Hardwood door - can be operated from  
both sides.

2'6" dia vent<sup>l</sup> - coaming 2'6" x 30 above shell<sup>l</sup> dk. fitted with wood plugs  
& canvas covers.

3, sidelights 10" dia (S.S.) fitted with metal deadlights

4" dia soil pipe discharge straight through shell with S.V. at shell, does  
not pass through deck. (S.S.)

2" dia wash basin discharge straight through shell with S.V. at shell, does  
not pass through deck. (S.S.)
