PORt SIDE.

The seventh plate from forward in the second strake below Upper Deck sheerstrake, slightly indented.

Shell flange of bulkhead frame in way of above plate, slightly bent.

That this plate be fairied in place.

Bulkhead frame bar to be released as necessary, fairied in place, reriveted, and recaulked.

That on account of coal cargo and bunker coal in way of the damage, which prevented an internal examination, the bulkhead plating if at all damaged, to be dealt
