The s.s. "EMPIRE ROCK" has been placed in dry dock at this Port. She is being bought by S.G. Embiricus, Superintendent Mr. Ventouris. The vessel is at present classed with British Corporation.

Dr. Pickworth has passed on to us correspondence with Mr. Cook and Mr. Sladden on the case, also an unstamped plan of Midship Section. No plan of Profile and Decks has been obtained so far as the builders state it cannot be found. Will you please forward sister vessels' plans for our use.

It is the Owner's intention to transfer the class to Lloyd's Register and they propose to defer the Special Survey until this becomes due next year. In the meantime we are carrying out a general examination of the vessel as far as possible without opening up tanks or machinery or boilers and the shell will not be drilled. The tail shaft also will not be drawn at this time.

The Owners desire the freeboard marking on the vessel to be changed to L.R. now and we will be pleased to receive new freeboard certificates for issue to the vessel. If possible, kindly forward British Corporation C.11 Report if it can be obtained from the Ministry.

Subject to the above we shall be pleased to learn the class to be recommended. Please forward all instructions in the matter by telegram as soon as possible as the vessel is leaving early next week.

The vessel, Bartram's No. 296, is stated to be similar to "EMPIRE TOURIST" and "EMPIRE BLESSING", Bartram's Nos. 297 and 298, which are classed by us.
