BUILT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES AND REQUIREMENTS OF THE SOCIETY: AND,

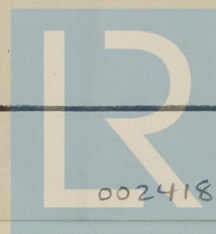
THAT I HAVE RECOMMENDED THAT THE TURBINE IS ENTITLED TO
