Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in *Extract from Log Rpt 8. No. 22370. 30/6/43*

GUNNERS ACCOMMODATION fitted in bridge tween deck space - starboard side.

Companionway of steel plating and angles, strongly constructed in way of bridge deck coal hatch - deck opening being 3' 0" x 2' 3" and remainder of hatch efficiently plated over.

6 - 12" diameter portlights fitted to shell side plating. One W.C. fitted on upper deck with usual storm valve discharging overboard above Freeboard deck.

3 - 6" diameter ventilators and 2 swan neck ventilator 8" x 4" fitted on bridge deck to those spaces and wood plugs and canvas covers supplied.
