With reference to your letter of the 13th December last, I have to acquaint you that a report has now come to hand, from which it appears that the steamer "WEST RARITANS", now named "EMPIRE MAVIS", has been surveyed in the United States, for the assignment of Convention Freeboards. In the circumstances I enclose for transmission to the Managers an Assignment Letter, and I shall be glad if you will ascertain and let me know when and at what port the freeboards will be marked and verified, and the conditions of assignment complied with. I may add that the Baltimore Surveyor issued a Provisional Load Line Certificate on the 5th April, valid for six months.
